### PA Department of Aging

### PA Department of Agriculture

Department of Agriculture provides a variety of state and federal grant programs that invest in Pennsylvania agriculture to grow opportunities and resources, remove barriers to entry, and inspire future generations of leaders within agriculture. ### PA Liquor Control Board

### PA Office of the Budget

Office of the Budget RACP program provides grants and funding for the construction of regional economic, cultural, civic, recreational, and historical improvement projects. A project is eligible for RACP funding only if that project has been itemized in a PA Capital Budget Project Itemization Act, and such itemizations have remaining "Project Allocation" amounts and have not been statutorily "sunset."
